

Gregory Mandry - Director

Gregory won his first award for directing for a theatre, 1-act play festival aged 16. He has been a resident director at the LOST Theatre in West London and In addition, he has directed shows for the Edinburgh Fringe Festival, Dublin Fringe Festival and many shows on the London Fringe. Critically acclaimed in the national press as a talented young gun, and a star to follow, he has worked on shows from classical Shakespeare to (and predominantly) contemporary modern works.

He worked as a photographer for 5 years before attending Film School. Whilst at and since leaving film school, he worked for 3 years as a camera assistant and camera operator with the BBC and London News. He has had a short films screened at BAFTA As part of a 'most promising new talent' screening and another was shown as part of the Edinburgh film festival.

Working as either part of the camera/ lighting crew or within the direction department Gregory has worked on feature films, television and stage.

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Gregory is now a director of the independent production company, Big Yellow Feet. For the company he has directed and been the Director of Photography numerous music promos, Arts Council shorts, corporate work and television features.
